Environmental Action Plan

The final presentation by the students of Pennsylvania State University regarding the Local Climate Action Program was provided via Zoom to the Board of Supervisors and the Environmental Advisory Commission. When complete, the students will provide the comprehensive report including a visual roadmap tailored specifically for Buckingham Township's goals and unique characteristics.

Mrs. Strout of the Environmental Advisory Commission recommended that going forward there should be a steering committee to organize implementation of the report.

Our Lady of Guadalupe Lighting Plan, Cold Spring Creamery Road, Tax Map Parcel #06-006-006

Monsignor Gentili was present to explain that the church had received a grant to install lighting in the back part of the parking lot and requested guidance and permission to install the lighting. He said the request is due to a need to reduce vandalism, partying, and vagrancy in the back area of the parking lot.

Mr. Gray noted that he had reviewed the proposed lighting plan and said that the lighting is designed to be motion activated and set at 30%, the lowest dimmable setting.
