The Work Session commenced with Executive Session at 5:30 p.m. to discuss potential real estate easement purchase offers and ongoing Lykon, McArdle, Bodine and Froehlich litigation matters.

Audio Visual System Update

Mrs. Rash said the township received a 3rd quote today from Haverford narrowing the scope of the proposed system per the township's request.

Mrs. Rash asked Mr. Gombosi to clarify his comment during a previous meeting regarding the speakers having a support system that was "unconscious" and "not amplified". Mr. Gombosi, Mechanicsville Road, replied those are the different styles of speakers, one was booming (active, internally amplified) and one was passive. He said the township could use the current camera and a computer for the system. Mrs. Rash said if we can stream the meetings with our current camera, why go through the entire proposal process, as that had been her sole reason to make any improvements. Mr. Bateman said if we've been able to stream the meetings, then why haven't we? Mrs. Rash asked if we just bought a new camera that was mounted, if there was a way to plug it in so it can stream and Mr. Gombosi replied "yes".

Mr. Forest asked why the revised quote is \$42,000 if it's just for a camera. Mrs. Cozza said it included more than a camera, adding that per the Boards' request, the proposal had been narrowed down by removing microphones and speakers along with some other items, but it does say we need their amplifier and camera, and the controls for the camera.

Discussion was held on piecing together equipment with a new mounted camera and fixing the speaker wire at the podium so that it works with the existing sound system. Mr. Bateman said that still wouldn't work to share presentations on the livestream. He said he would like the township to have a system that's easy to use and grows with technology.

Mr. Bateman said the newest quote from Haverford is \$41,961 with the monitor, and will allow streaming from the monitor onto the internet via the computer. Mrs. Cozza said we would continue using YouTube where the township videos are stored now.

Mr. Forest said that money was budgeted for the system and it was time to pull the plug.
